Symbiosis Law School, being a constituent of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) has Five years integrated Under-graduate Law Programs both, B.A L.L.B and B.B.A L.L.B and One year Master of Laws, L.L.M program. - Any other activity which the RAC may feel appropriate.

Academic Integrity Committee
